Wilderness First Aid Course

The City of Greenleaf is hosting a Wilderness First Aid Course on Friday and Saturday, July 17-18, at the Greenleaf Community Center. This two-day training is designed to equip participants with essential first aid and emergency response skills for outdoor and remote environments. Topics include patient assessment, trauma management, environmental emergencies such as hypothermia and dehydration, and effective team response when help may be delayed. The course runs from 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. each day. Cost is \$180 per person. For registration information and additional details, please contact Greenleaf City Hall.
